ITINERARY

Day 1 - Sep. 24: Depart U.S.A.

Our spiritual journey begins as we depart on our transatlantic flight to Barcelona. Meals and drinks will be served aloft.


Day 2 - Sep. 25: Arrive Barcelona

Upon arrival in Barcelona we will be met by our local tour manager who will be with us throughout our pilgrimage. Transfer to our hotel with the remainder of the day free.



Day 3 - Sep. 26: Barcelona

After breakfast we will enjoy a panoramic tour of Barcelona including views of the harbor area, Montjuic, Plaza de Espana and Plaza de Catalunya. We will then visit Barcelona Cathedral followed by a visit to Gaudi's La Sagrada Familia, a magnificent, unfinished Roman Catholic basilica of impressive proportions. We will continue on to the Tibidabo Hill where we will visit the Church of the Sacred Heart and see a statue of Christ whose extended arms overlooking Barcelona reminds one of Rio de Janeiro.



Day 4 - Sep. 27: Barcelona / Montserrat / Barcelona

Today we will travel outside of Barcelona to visit the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Montserrat, the spiritual heart of Catalonia and home to a dramatically-set Benedictine monastery. For 700 years this Marian shrine has attracted thousands of pilgrims from around the world. We pause here to visit the Black Madonna of Montserrat, probably Spain's most fervent devotion to the Blessed Mother.

Return to Barcelona and explore the colorful markets of Las Ramblas before returning to our hotel.

Day 5 - Sep. 28: Barcelona / Lourdes

Depart Barcelona and drive to Andorra la Vella to visit the Shrine of Our Lady of Meritxell. After Mass we will continue on to Lourdes, one of the great pilgrimage shrines in the world. It was here in Lourdes where Our Lady appeared to St. Bernadette in 1858 proclaiming herself the "Immaculate Conception".



Day 6 - Sep. 29: Lourdes

This morning we will attend Mass at the Grotto of Massabielle, the site where the Virgin appeared. After Mass we will enjoy a tour including visits to the Basilica of Pius X (the world's largest underground church), see the house where Bernadette lived during the Apparitions, and visit several of the sites where the miraculous cures have taken place. The remainder of the afternoon is free to explore Lourdes on your own during which time you may wish to visit the miraculous baths. This evening we will participate in the Blessed Sacrament Procession and the Candlelight Procession.



Day 7 - Sep. 30: Lourdes / Zaragoza

Depart Lourdes and cross the border into Spain. Then proceed to the Sanctuary of Torreciudad in Huesca for a visit. Continue our drive west to Zaragoza which is the capital of Aragón and Spain's fifth largest city. The

highlight of our sightseeing tour of Zaragoza will include a visit and Mass at the Shrine of Our Lady of Pilar where the Blessed Virgin appeared to St. James in 40 AD. We will also visit the Plaza del Pilar and the La Seo Cathedral.

Day 8 - Oct. 1: Zaragoza / Avila

Depart Zaragoza this morning and drive to Segovia where we will visit the great Gothic Cathedral, the extraordinary Alcazar fortress, the splendid Roman Aqueduct and the Monastery of San Juan De La Cruz where we will see the tomb of St. John of the Cross who served as spiritual director to St. Teresa of Avila. Then proceed to Avila, the birthplace of St. Teresa, for overnight.



Day 9 - Oct. 2: Avila / Salamanca

This morning we will visit the Monastery of the Incarnation where St. Teresa spent many years of her life, the Monastery of St. Joseph, and the Convent of St. Teresa. We will then depart Avila and drive to Alba de Tormes to visit the Carmelite Convent which contains St. Teresa's incorrupt arm and heart. Then continue on to Salamanca for overnight.

Day 10 - Oct. 3: Salamanca / Fatima

This morning we will enjoy a short tour of Salamanca including a visit to the Plaza Mayor, which is regarded as one of the most attractive squares in Spain, and the Cathedrals Vieja and Nueva. Then depart Salamanca and drive to Coimbra, a famous university town, to visit the Convent of Santa Clara La Nova where St. Isabella is buried. Continue on to Fatima for overnight.



Day 11 - Oct. 4: Fatima

As in most small villages in the early years of the century, the parish church was the center of life and faith in Fatima. It was here that the three children were baptized and Lucy made her first confession at six years of age. The kindly priest who heard her confession told her to consecrate herself to the Blessed Virgin and she immediately did this in front of the statue of Our Lady of the Rosary. The following day she took Holy Communion for the first time. Jacinta also frequently came here to pray. Once on the feast of the Ascension, the Blessed Virgin appeared and asked them to pray the rosary every day and ask for world peace. After Mass at the Chapel of the Apparitions, visit the Basilica to see the site of Francisco and Jacinta's graves and the village where the three children lived. Continue to Valinhos where Our Lady appeared to the children following their release. This evening participate in the candlelight vigil.

Day 12 - Oct. 5: Fatima / Lisbon / U.S.A.

This morning we will transfer to the airport in Lisbon to catch our return flight home.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND CONDITIONS

Reservations and Payment: Please complete the attached Reservation Application and return it with your deposit of \$300.00 per person at the time of booking. Final payment is due 95 days prior to departure.

Cancellations: All cancellations must be in writing. The following per person cancellation charges will apply: If canceled 91 days or more prior to departure, a \$50.00 administrative fee will be charged. If canceled 90 - 61 days prior to departure, \$250.00 will be charged. If canceled 60 - 31 days prior to departure, \$450.00 will be charged. If canceled 30 - 7 days prior to departure \$700.00 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 6 days of departure. In addition, once the airline tickets have been issued, 100% of the airfare is non-refundable unless you have been advised otherwise at the time of your booking. Additional cancellation charges may apply depending upon the cancellation terms of our suppliers.

Refunds: Subject to the foregoing Cancellation Terms, upon cancellation of travel related services, all sums paid to George's International Tours for such services will be promptly returned to the passenger, provided the passenger has not caused such cancellation and is not in violation of any of the terms and conditions previously, clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the passenger. This refund provision does not apply where George's International Tours has remitted the payment to another registered seller of travel or a carrier and they default in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service without providing a refund. In such a situation, George's International Tours agrees to provide passenger with a written statement accompanied by a copy of the bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a seller of travel, proof of their current registration.

Trust Account Disclosure: California law requires certain sellers of travel to have a trust account or bond. George's International Tours has such a trust account.

Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"): George's International Tours is a participant in the Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation ("TCRC"). You, the passenger, may request reimbursement from TCRC if the Seller of Travel was registered and participating in the TCRC at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Please be advised that passengers purchasing from outside of California are not covered by the TCRC. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRC if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the Seller of Travel failed to forward to a proper provider or if such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRC to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the Seller of Travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRC within six months after the scheduled completion date of the travel. A claim must include sufficient information and documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. You must agree to waive your right to other civil remedies against a registered participating Seller of Travel for matters arising out of a sale for which you file a claim with the TCRC, if you were located in California at the time of the sale. You may request a claim form by writing to: Travel Consumer Restitution Corporation, P.O. Box 6001, Larkspur, CA 94977-6001; or by faxing a request to 415-927-7698.

Travel Documents: A passport with a minimum of 6 months validity remaining is required of all U.S. citizens. U.S. citizens do not require visas for entry to the countries being visited on this tour. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please call to find out if you need a visa. George's International is not responsible for visas or passports.

Tour Cost: All quoted prices are based upon airfares, tariffs and currency exchange rates at the time of printing and are subject to change at any time. Should the minimum number of 30 tour members not be reached, the right is reserved to increase the tour cost accordingly.

Tour Documents and Tickets: Final tour documents are mailed, provided we have received full payment, within 3 weeks of departure.

Baggage: Each passenger is allowed one checked bag and one carry-on. You will be responsible for paying to the airline any additional charges for additional checked baggage or overweight baggage (if excess weight is permitted). George's International Tours is not responsible for lost, damaged or stolen baggage.

Air Transportation: Air travel is in economy class on Delta Airlines/American Airlines/United Airlines (or any other IATA carrier). Fares are based upon levels in effect at the time of printing. Fares and flight schedules are subject to change without notice.

Hotels: Accommodations are based upon double occupancy rooms. A limited number of single rooms are available at the supplement quoted and should be requested at the time of booking.

Travel Insurance: The trip cost includes basic travel insurance covering travel delays, missed connections, medical expenses and lost/delayed baggage.
